FOR WHAT PURPOSE DO WE PROCESS YOUR PERSONAL DATA?

At UCEIF, we process the information provided by our participants in events, congresses, seminars, and forums, to regulate the control of access to the facilities, list of attendees, accreditations, parking management of attendees' vehicles, as well as for subsequent contact with attendees via email, commercial action and sending newsletters.

1. To manage the registration and participation of users in the Explorer programmes: One of the primary purposes of the website is to serve as a meeting place for people interested in the portal's subject matter so they can find the information and services in which they may be interested. Therefore, we will process user data for the registration of users in the various programs and projects that are carried out on the web, mainly training programs for entrepreneurship; initiatives to put users in contact with "Explorer spaces" in which to work; mentoring and personalized advice; networking with other users of the community; and the presentation of ideas and projects whose participants may be eligible to be the winners of specific trips to meet entrepreneurial ecosystems such as Google or Facebook.

The legitimacy that allows to enable this treatment is the execution of a contract that is materialized with the acceptance of this privacy policy.

2. To carry out statistical studies on the use of the services by users. UCEIF will process user data to carry out statistical analyses that allow us to know the effectiveness and usefulness of the services provided on the website so that the results obtained will allow us to improve the services and programs offered in the future. The legitimacy that enables this treatment is the legitimate interest of UCEIF.

HOW LONG WILL WE KEEP YOUR DATA?

The personal data provided will be kept only as long as the contractual relationship is maintained or as long as the contact for informative actions is maintained and the deletion is not requested by the interested party, or by legal obligation.

WHAT IS THE LEGITIMACY OF THE PROCESSING OF YOUR DATA?

The legal basis for processing your data is the contractual relationship and/or your consent.

WHAT ARE YOUR RIGHTS WHEN YOU PROVIDE US WITH YOUR DATA?

Any person has the right to obtain confirmation as to whether or not the UCEIF is processing personal data concerning them. In addition, interested parties have the right to access their personal data and request the rectification of inaccurate data or, where appropriate, request its deletion when, among other reasons, the data is no longer necessary for the purposes for which it was collected. Finally, in certain circumstances, interested parties may request the limitation of processing their data, in which case we will only keep them for the exercise or defence of claims.

COOKIE POLICY ON EXPLORERBYX.ORG.

4. Types of Cookies used on the Web

Session identifier. Stores information about the user who is currently visiting the website.

Expires: end of browser session

_utma

It is used to distinguish users and sessions. The cookie is created when the javascript library is executed and the _utma cookie does not exist. The cookie is updated every time you send data to Google Analytics.

Expires: 2 years.

_utmb

It is used to determine new visits or sessions. The cookie is created when the javascript library is executed and the _utmb cookie does not exist. The cookie is updated every time you send data to Google Analytics.

Expires: 20 minutes.

_utmz

Not used in ga.js. Set for interoperability with urchin.js. Historically, this cookie operated in conjunction with the _____ utmb cookie to determine if the user was in a new session/visit.

Expires: end of browser session.

_utmz

Stores the traffic source or a campaign that explains how the user arrived at your site. The cookie is created when the javascript library is set and updated each time you send data to Google Analytics.

Expires: 6 months.

Owner: Google Analytics Duration: Session Category: Analytics. Function: Used to limit the collection of traffic data on websites with high number of visits.

Type: Third parties

Another form of measuring website usage and personalization technologies is the use of Flash-cookies, created by Adobe-Flash. 5. Additional Notes
